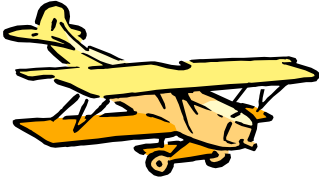

Minutes of the Meeting, January 8, 2007

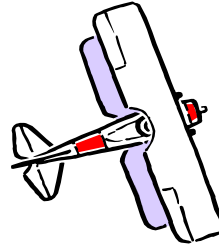

Treasurer Tom Goeddel reported a balance in the treasury of \$1504.50. The chapter charter has been renewed and we are up to date with National.

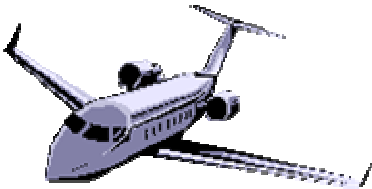

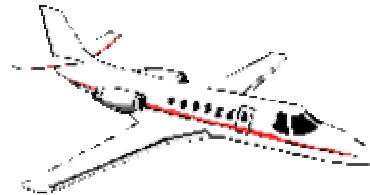
OLD BUSINESS

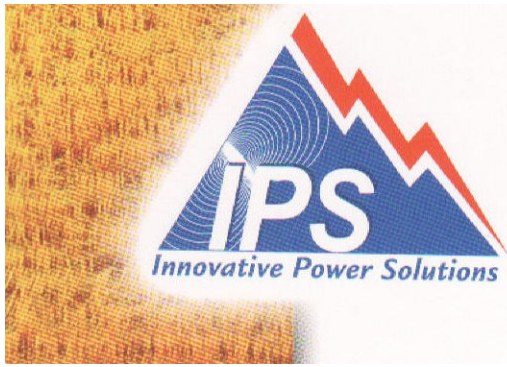

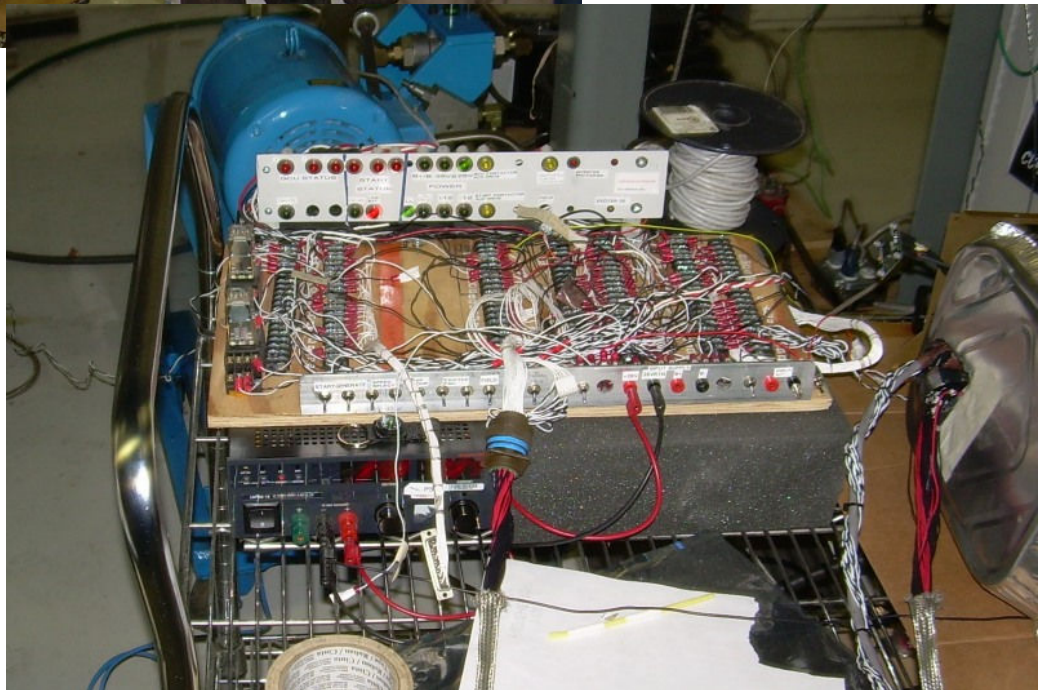

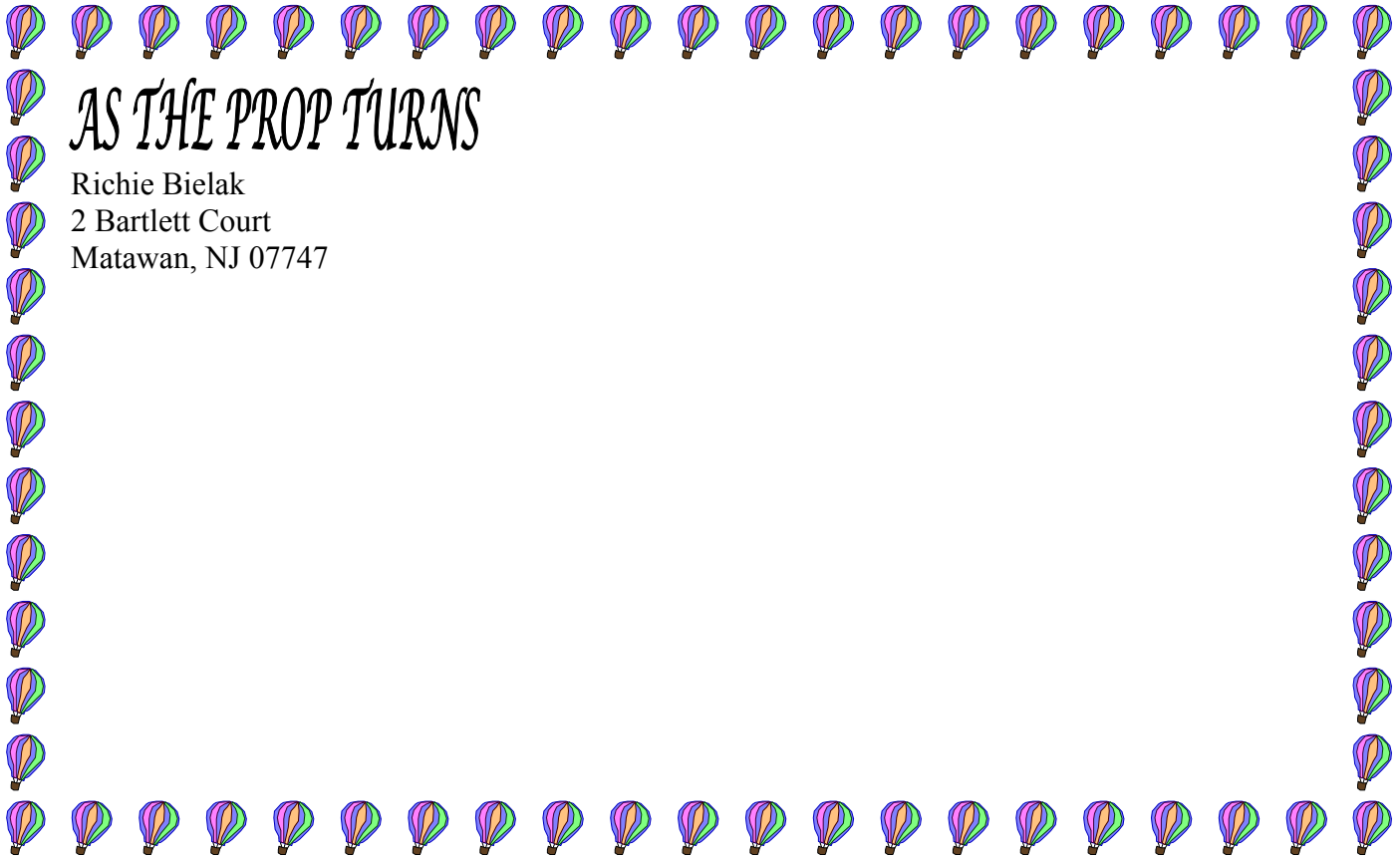
George turning the machine on for a sample test of the starter.
